

Maine Youth Football Organization League Rules and Enforcement Policy

As a Maine Youth Football coach you are required to sign and submit the Coaches Code of Ethics Pledge. Adherence to this Pledge is a requirement for participation in Maine Youth Football. Failure to comply may result in participation revocation as outlined in the League Rules and Enforcement Policy.

Coaches Code of Ethics

I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win.

I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the large range emotional and physical development for the same age group.

I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.

I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.

I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players.

I will provide a sports environment for my team that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and I will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.

I will be knowledgeable in the rules of Maine Youth Football, and I will teach these rules to my players.

I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills that I teach.

I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.

I will teach safe football techniques that reinforce safety to both the individual and opponent.

I certify that I have read and agree to uphold Maine Youth Football League Rules and Enforcement Policy.
